Nibor Benchmark Statement published

NoRe has today published its Benchmark Statement for the Nibor interest rate benchmark.

On 12 October 2020, the Norwegian Financial Supervisory Authority, Finanstilsynet, informed NoRe of its approval of NoRe's application for authorisation as administrator for Nibor according to the requirements following the EU Benchmarks Regulation (BMR). Shortly after this, NoRe was included in the register The European Securities and Markets Authority, ESMA, is publishing in accordance with Article 36 of the BMR.

According to BMR Article 27 an administrator shall within two weeks of the inclusion in the above-mentioned register publish a benchmark statement. Article 27 specifies the required content of the benchmark statement, which is specified further in the Regulatory Technical Standard provided by the EU Commission Delegated Regulation 2018/1643 of 13 July 2018.

NoRe has today published its Nibor Benchmark Statement. The statement is available on our web page [The Nibor Framework](#).

We hope that the Nibor Benchmark Statement will prove to be a useful tool for current and potential users of Nibor when it comes to choosing between benchmarks and assessing risks, by gathering information about Nibor and the Nibor Framework in one single document.
